WHAT MOVES YOU

- You recognizing the importance of rebuilding family bonds
- Growing and mastering your skills and knowledge in your field
- Being an exceptional team member providing exceptional services
- Adhering to high standards of services to clients and the documentation the role requires

WHAT YOU'LL DO

- Provide supportive supervision of non-custodial parents and their children during access visits and monitored exchanges in a respectful and non-judgmental way that respects the role of the parent
- Greet and spend time with each client prior to the visit asking the client about their goals for the visit and document this interaction
- Be responsible for the maintenance, organization and cleaning of program supplies and materials

WHAT YOU'VE DONE

- Bachelor's degree or diploma in Human Services, Early Childhood Education, Child Studies or related field
- Awareness of the dynamics in a family violence situation and the risk factors involved
- Cultural sensitivity
