- Plan, develop and implement play-based activities for children (0 – 12 years)
- Relate to children at their developmental level
- Maintain a clean, secure and engaging playroom space.
- Commit to either one morning shift or afternoon for 3 months
- Morning Shift: (9:45 am to 12:15 pm)
- Afternoon Shift: (1 – 4pm)  
(Every Thursday)

#### WHAT YOU'VE DONE

- Experience working with children aged infant to 12 years is preferred.
- Alberta childcare certification is preferred.
- Experience in direct service provision with families in crisis and ability to work independently is an asset
- Knowledge of child development
- Creative problem solving skills
- Excellent verbal communication skills.
