MAINTENANCE WORKER, FACILITIES (1.0 FTE)

This position is responsible for general and specialized maintenance duties, snow removal, grounds care and other related activities. This position requires someone who can work flexible hours as shift work and weekend duties may be required.

- Undertake repairs and maintenance to building (ex. plumbing, electrical, painting) and perform repairs on company equipment, machinery and appliances.
- Work collaboratively with various contractors, and ensure that proper repairs are being performed.
- Ensure that safety standards are met at all times.
- Communicate with other building operators through the use of Work Management Systems.

- A minimum of 2 years' working experience in a similar role.
- HVAC, etc.
- Experience with light trade work (Plumbing, electrical, carpentry, painting, locksmith, etc)
- Solid experience with plumbing and electrical systems.
- Valid WHMIS training certification and valid First Aid certification
- Extremely organized with good communication skills.
- Experience working with boilers, chillers, HVAC, etc.
- Ability to operate snow removal, grass cutting equipment
- Ability to work independently as well as part of a team
