## FAMILIES FORWARD FACILITATOR - FAMILY RESOURCE NETWORK ( 1.0 FTE)

The Families Forward Facilitator (FFF) delivers in-home caregiving and education to develop caregiver capacity in service of infants, children, and youth living safely in the community. The FFF helps caregivers/parents learn problem solving, communication and parenting skills.

### WHAT MOVES YOU

- Knowing that although we might work with people experiencing crisis we don't work in crisis

### WHAT YOU'LL DO

- Provide in-home education and support to parents and caregivers to improve their confidence, and learn new behaviours (strategies) to help families function in a safer and healthier way.
- Complete all clients' files and program documentation within specified timelines and quality standards.
- Aim to exceeding program expectations in alignment with the program's designated evidence-based model of practice.
- Maintain up to date knowledge of relevant community resources.
- ***This work involves some evening and weekend work hours and requires travel throughout network, access to a vehicle is required.***

### WHAT YOU'VE DONE

- Diploma or degree in Social Work, Child and Youth Care Nursing or other *relevant* educational background. Registration with the appropriate regulatory body is required.
- At least two years of experience working with children, youth, and families in the field of child mistreatment, family conflict, domestic violence and trauma.
- Solid understanding of Child Development and Brain Science.
- At least one year *specific experience* delivering home visitation programming, establishing intervention priorities and balancing competing caseload demands.
- Ability to generate recommendations in high pressure situations.
- Ability to deliver programming in a variety of community settings.
- Current First Aid and CPR required.
