### FAMILY CHAMPION FACILITATOR - FAMILY RESOURCE NETWORK (TEMP POSITION)

The Family Champion Facilitator delivers dynamic and engaging activities in different network settings to families with children of all ages. The person in this role will need to demonstrate continuous improvement, collaboration and work from the perspective that all families have potential. This position delivers accessible, strengths-focused, and evidence-based programming in network communities.

You will support children of all ages and their caregivers in developing resilience, skills, and healthy living, to strengthen family bonds and create a path for positive child development.

### WHAT MOVES YOU

- Being a part of a team that focuses on enhancing the caregiver capacity and supporting healthy child development.
- You demonstrate thoughtfulness in decision-making.
- Engaging groups of people and building them through your great interpersonal skills.
- Although we might work with people experiencing crisis, we do not work in crisis.

### WHAT YOU'LL DO

- Deliver accessible, strengths-focused, and evidence-based programming in network communities.
- Provide coaching, guidance and strategies to parents and caregivers on different issues,
- Support the healthy growth and development of children by delivering developmentally appropriate activities.
- Provide and deliver activities in a timely and structured fashion.
- Use program technology to communicate and record information as required.
- Aim to exceed program expectations in alignment with the program's designated approach(s).
- Complete documentation, ensure reports are accurate, and recorded in a timely manner.
- Maintain knowledge of relevant best practices and resources (within and outside of the FRN).
- Ensure service delivery is aligned with YW Calgary's vision, mission, and practice framework.
- **This role is a temporary position with end date of February 17, 2023.**
- **This position involves evening and weekend work hours with travel throughout network so access to a vehicle is required.**

### WHAT YOU'VE DONE

- Diploma or degree in Social Work, Child and Youth Care, or Nursing with registration with the appropriate regulatory body.
- At least two years of experience working with children, youth, and families.
- Understanding of child development, brain science and solid knowledge of child maltreatment.
- Ability to deliver programming in a variety of community settings.
- Experience working effectively with diverse communities.
- Engage with families in a manner that is responsive to and respectful of diversity.
- Excellent communication and rapport building skills and deliver presentations.
- Perform duties and engage colleagues in an ethical manner that adheres to relevant standards of practice.
- Current first aid and CPR required.

As a condition of employment, YW Calgary requires the successful candidate to be fully vaccinated.
