As the Family Support Worker for the COMPASS Program, you will provide in-home parenting education and support to parents in building healthy relationships and improving family functioning. Families with children (newborns – 12 years old) experiencing behavioral, emotional and social challenges are referred to the program by other professionals in the community.

WHAT MOVES YOU

- Supporting families with a professional and caring approach
- The success of your clients are a source of joy to you
- You are able to engage and develop trusting professional relationships with clients/families
- You love diversity and are responsive to it

WHAT YOU’LL DO

- Schedule visits with families in their homes and/or community.
- Plan and prepare for each visit based on client needs through research and program materials
- Engage and develop a trusting professional relationship with the family.
- Provide parents with positive parenting strategies and skills and support the implementation process.
- Provide social-skill development and problem-solving strategies with identified client and provide information to parent(s).
- Connect and liaise with referral source and other professionals involved with clients
- Conduct school/day observations with parent’s and school’s permission.
- Complete all case notes, client file management and paperwork requirements within deadlines.
- Provide families with information about resources and empower them with access
- **Vehicle is required.**

WHAT YOU’VE DONE

- Degree or diploma in social work or equivalent in related human service field
- Minimum two years of in-home experience providing parenting education, support, child development information and strategies
- Eligibility for registration with Alberta College of Social Workers
- Valid First Aid Certificate
- Valid driver’s license and reliable automobile with business use insurance
- Current Criminal Record check
- Current Intervention Records check (Calgary Child and Family Services)

As a condition of employment, YW Calgary requires the successful candidate to be fully vaccinated.
