- Bringing energy and new ideas to shape and ensuring excellence in all facets
- Your flexibility and quick thinking in modifying activities and play if necessary

WHAT YOU’LL DO

- Provide day-to-day childcare in a safe, secure, consistent environment in which children are able to grow and develop through play
- Be responsible for the health, safety and well-being of the children and their supervision
- Maintain a child friendly, stimulating play room environment with age and developmentally appropriate games and activities
- Engage children in multi-age groups creatively and in outdoor activities with enthusiasm
- Oversee all mealtime/snack time activities and diapering/toileting support
- Maintain daily attendance records according to program and licensing standards
- Clean the playroom according to schedule and prepare for and participate in inspections
- Maintain stock levels of supplies and assist childcare workers in research and implementing appropriate activities
- Conduct registration intakes with mothers of new children entering the program

WHAT YOU’VE DONE

- Early learning and Child Care Certificate/Diploma or equivalent
- Alberta Childcare Certification as Child Development Worker (level 2) or higher
- Knowledge of Alberta Health Standards and child care regulations for Daycare
- Child Care First Aid & CPR
- Police Check with Vulnerable Sector Search and a cleared Child Intervention Check required
- Ability to accept feedback and incorporate feedback into productive work
- Strong communication skills both orally and written
- Physical ability to sit, bend, kneel and lift up to 30 lbs while interacting with children
